Saul - 1 Samuel 13:1 - **Saul** was thirty years old when he became **king**, and he reigned over Israel forty- two years.



Changing water into wine – John 2: 1-10 - 2 On the third day a wedding took place at Cana in Galilee. Jesus' mother was there, and Jesus and his disciples had also been invited to the wedding. When the wine was gone, Jesus' mother said to him, "they have no more wine". "Woman, why do you involve me?" Jesus replied. "My hour has not yet come." His mother said to the servants, "Do whatever he tells you". Nearby stood 6 stone jars, the kind used by the Jews for ceremonial washing, each holding 20 to 30 gallons. Jesus said, "Fill the jars with water."; so they filled them to the brim. Then he told them, "Now draw some out and take it to the Master of the banquet". They did do this, and the Master of the Banquet tasted the water that had been turned into wine. He did not realize where it had come from, though the servants who had drawn the water knew. Then he called the bridegroom aside and said, "Everyone brings out the choice wine first then the cheaper wine after the guests had had too much to drink; but you have saved the best until now." So that the Roman Empire could take a census – Luke 2:1-7 - 2 In those days Caesar Augustus issued a decree that a census should be taken of the entire Roman world. (This was the first census that took place while Quirinius was the governor of Syria.) And everyone went to their own town to register. So Joseph also went up from the Town of Nazareth in Galilee to Judea, to Bethlehem the town of David, because he belonged to the house and line of David. He went their to register with Mary, who was pledged to be married to him and was expecting a child. While they were there, the time came for the baby to be born, and she gave birth to her first born, a son. She wrapped him cloths and placed him in a manger, because their was not a guest room available for them.


